Discussion Summary:

Subject 1: Unification Of UFGS 01 33 00 Submittal Procedures

- 1) Rick Hatcher summarized the way the 01 33 00 unification process was done.
 - a) Originally, the 3 Sections for each agency were combined into one file.
 - b) Merged portions of the section related to how a contractor processes the submittals.
 - c) Agency process could not be unified because each agency has their own unique way.
- 2) SGS distributed the new section for review.
- 3) Steve responded in an email that he did not like the use of agency editor options via notes and brackets and wanted it done using ARMY, NAVY, and NASA tailoring options.
- 4) Steve stated the notes addressing actions in following paragraphs should be moved and included within the paragraph being addressed. Use "Delete this paragraph" instead of "Delete the following paragraph." This will assure that the note will be removed when the appropriate action is taken. Otherwise, people may subsequently "delete the following paragraph" until none remain.
- 5) NASA and Army agreed that we are on the right track, but it still required some work.
- 6) Sherri commented that a lot of the Navy's process is very similar to NASA's. Possibly those areas could be unified between NASA and Navy using the tailoring options,

1) A discussion was held and will be worked on a section by section basis over the course of time.

Subject 3: UFGS General Scope Note Regarding Editing of Section

- 1) A discussion was held regarding the General Scope Note.
- 2) The Working Group decided to table the discussion until the SI-CCCB Meeting the following day, due to some of the members wanting to have time to prepare different wording for the additions.
- 3) These changes will be implemented into the UFGS Template (covered under Subject 9)
- 4) Information that is more detailed will be covered in the SI-CCCB Meeting Minutes.

Subject 4: Status Of Agreement On Reference Identifiers (RID)

- 1) Carl Kersten stated the contract with Information Handling Services (IHS) was initiated October 1 2006. The contract is funded by DoD.
- 2) Each agency has identified the references with discrepancies.
- 3) Sheron stated there were still a lot of open items when the reference no longer exist and there is no replacement. This item will need a technical person to review and recommend the correct reference.
- Carl Kersten stated that we will wait for the first list from IHS and then decide the next course of action.

 - Once the sections are merged, they will be distributed to each of the agencies for review and approval.
 - Tailoring will be kept to a minimum in Division 1. In Division 2 49 tailoring will be implemented by product.
